



## **KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION**

### **2009/2010 SCHOOL YEAR**

**Applications** Kindergarten applicants must be age 5 by December 1, 2009.

**Notification of Acceptance or Waiting List Status** Please return your completed application directly to the CCS office. You will be notified of acceptance or waiting status. Classes will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

**School Year** August 31, 2009 - June 10, 2010

**School Hours** Kindergarten is a full-day schedule from 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

**Tuition** Kindergarten tuition for the 2009/2010 school year will be \$4310. Multiple child discounts for this year are \$750 for the second child and \$1000 for each additional child. Tuition is payable in ten monthly payments due the first of the month, August through May. There is a late fee of \$25 if tuition is not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. Please note: a \$100 discount, per tuition, is available for all tuitions paid in full by July 20.

**Registration Fee** The registration fee of \$235 is due at the time of registration and becomes non-refundable upon acceptance.

**Curriculum** CCS uses a Christian curriculum from BJU Press. It stresses the fundamentals, while integrating Christian values and Scripture. In our Bible class we use the Hands on Bible curriculum. This is a fun and exciting, hands on approach introducing the Bible. Kindergarten students learn to read by learning each letter and its sounds, and applying the phonics rules learned to progress through blends and final sounds. They will learn to count and print to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's. They will also learn addition up to the 10's family. There is no entrance testing. Students will be introduced to computers in our computer lab as well as the classroom. We have also implemented the Accelerated Reader Program starting in Kindergarten through Eighth grade.

**Car Pools** Parents may select to have their information made available through the school's carpool database in the CCS office. Parents may then make their own contacts and arrangements.

**Discipline** The school uses the assertive discipline method for correcting behavior problems. Prayer and counseling, together with the warning/natural consequence/detention system, are usually very effective.

**Spiritual Life** Bible study and prayer are an integral part of our school. Each day will begin with prayer and Bible study. Chapels are held weekly. It is our desire that each of our students comes to know Jesus Christ in a personal way.
