



NEW STUDENT INFORMATION JUNIOR HIGH GRADES 6-8 2009/2010 SCHOOL YEAR

Applications Applicants in sixth- eighth grades must attach a copy of their most current report card as well as a copy of their most recent standardized test scores (previous years' scores are acceptable if current year is not available). There is no charge to apply.

Notification of Acceptance or Waiting List Status Please return your completed application directly to the CCS office. You will receive notification by mail of acceptance or waiting status. Classes will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

School Year/Hours August 31, 2009 -June 10, 2010. Hours are 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

Tuition Tuition for the 2009/2010 school year will be \$4,490. Multiple child discounts for this year are \$750 for the second child, \$1,000 for additional children. Tuition is payable in ten monthly payments due the first of each month, August through May. A late fee of \$25 will be applied if tuition is not paid by the 10th of the month. Please note: a \$100 discount, per tuition, is available for all tuitions paid in full by July 20.

Registration Fee The registration fee is \$235. New students may be required to pay a \$25 testing fee if testing is deemed necessary. The entire fee is due at the time of registration and becomes non-refundable upon acceptance.

Computers Our Junior High class has one laptop computer per student. Our system is wireless and networked.

Extended Day Care Extended care is provided for students K-8, Monday through Friday, from 7:30-8:00 a.m. and afternoons from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Charges are \$2 per student for a.m. care and \$3 per hour or any portion thereof, per student, for p.m. care.

Enrichment Courses Various courses are offered one day a week during the Fall and Spring semesters after school from 3:15-4:15 p.m. Day care fees are not charged when a student is participating in an Enrichment Course.

Science School Part of the **Sixth grade** curriculum is a week long Science School off campus. The students are required to attend this academic program held at one of several Christian camps in Northern California. The cost is approximately \$265. Students are given

the opportunity to raise the entire amount through fundraisers beginning in September.

Mission Trip Part of the **Seventh and Eighth grade** curriculum is a week long mission trip to La Posada, Mexico. The students are required to attend this trip. The cost is approximately \$265. Students are given the opportunity to raise the entire amount through fundraisers beginning in September.

Car Pools Parents may submit an information card at registration. The car pool information cards are indexed by location and then made available to parents to refer to in the CCS office. Parents may then make their own contacts and arrangements.

Dress Code We desire that school dress be appropriate, modest, and safe for school activities. Believing that God has given the responsibility for the nurture and care of your child to you, we are leaving the matter of clothing selection to you. However, in the case of questionable or immodest dress, the school will contact the parents to bring a change of clothes.

Hot Lunch Our hot lunch program is provided by local fast food vendors such as Arby's and Subway Sandwiches and Round Table Pizza at a reasonable cost to the students.

Discipline The school uses the assertive discipline method for correcting behavior problems. Prayer and counseling, together with the warning/natural consequence/detention system, are usually very effective. Repeat offenders will be sent to the Principal for prayer, exhortation, and if necessary, a parent conference.

Spiritual Life Bible study and prayer are an integral part of our school. Each day will begin with prayer. Students will attend a Bible class daily. Chapels will be held each week. It is our desire that each of our students comes to know Jesus Christ in a personal way.
